

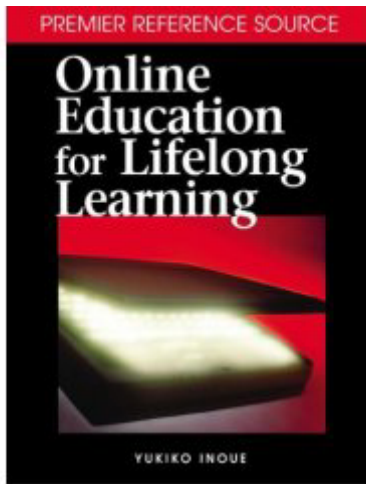
ONLINE EDUCATION FOR LIFELONG LEARNING
