Total population count after the sample was determined using the formula 384.

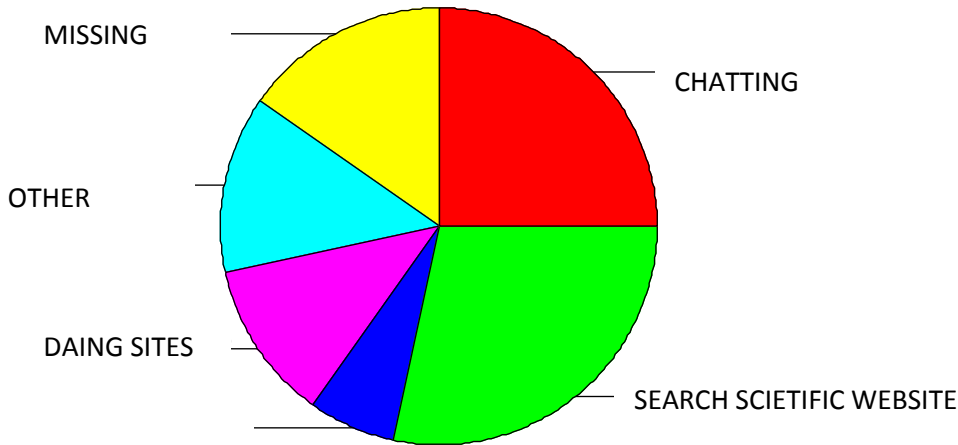

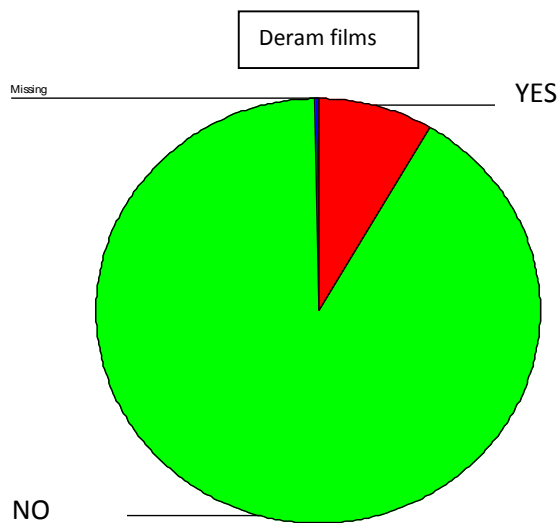
