In this issue, there are five scientific papers including two original articles, a review, a case report, and a letter. Ozsagir and Tunali review the preparation and indications of a novel blood product in medicine and dentistry; injectable platelet-rich fibrin. In the original article section, Dinleyici et al. analyzed the effectiveness of *Lactobacillus rhamnosus LGG* and *Bifidobacterium animalis* subspecies *lactis BB-12* combination on the duration of diarrhea and length of hospital stay in children with mild/moderate diarrhea in a multicenter randomize study.
