In the first article, Asil KAYA presents an account of President Kenan Evren's visit to the United Kingdom in 1988 and its impact on the relations between the two countries.

In the second article, Burcu KAYA describes the agreements signed by Zeki Kuneralp during his tenure as the Turkish Ambassador to London in 1964-1966, and 1969-1972.

Eda Nur YAVUZASLAN, in the third article, discusses the establishment of diplomatic relations between England and the Ottoman State in the 16th Century.

The fourth article, authored by Oğuzhan ALTIN, presents an evaluation of the activities of the British archaeologist, Lloyd Seton, and his contribution to the history and archaeology of Anatolia.

Fatma ALI ELBATANONY, in the fifth article, discusses Morocco's political relations with Europe, Russia and China.

The interview in this issue was conducted by Çiğdem BALIM with Dr Ozan ÖZAVCI, Assistant Professor of Transimperial History, and introduces the "Lausanne Project".

There are three book reviews in this issue. In the first, Mekki ULUDAĞ reviews *Promised Lands: The British and the Ottoman Middle East*, Princeton University Press by Jonathan Parry. Second, Atahan YEŞİLBURSA presents a review of Yuval Noah Harari's *Sapiens, a brief history of humankind*.
