Ethical Principles; The Karya Journal of Health Science is based on guidelines prepared as a guide for authors, referees, and editors by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) and the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE). In research articles involving human subjects, it should be explicitly stated in the "Methods" section that the research was approved by the relevant Ethics Committee, conducted in accordance with the Helsinki Declaration Principles (https://www.wma.net/what-we-do/medical-ethics/declarationof-helsinki/), and that informed consent of the participants and institutional permissions were obtained. Signed consent should be obtained in case presentations and clearly stated in the "Case Presentation" section. It is assumed that studies submitted to the Karya Journal of Health Science were conducted in accordance with the Helsinki Declaration Principles, and no responsibility will be accepted in this regard regarding institutional, ethical, and legal permissions. In studies involving animals, it should be clearly stated in the "Methods" section that the rights of animals were protected in accordance with the principles of the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (www.nap.edu/catalog/5140.html), and that the research was approved by the relevant Ethics Committee. Authors must guarantee that figures, images, photographs, tables, and other supplementary materials in the article are original. If previously published, attributed writing, tables, images, scales, or similar material belonging to others are used in the article, the authors are obligated to obtain written permission from the copyright holder(s) and indicate this in the article. Legal responsibility in this regard lies with the authors. Compliance with copyright regulations for used ideas and artistic works must be indicated. If there is any commercial connection or financial support provided by a company (directly or indirectly), the authors must disclose on the title page whether they have no commercial relationship with the products, drugs, or company used or if there is such a relationship, how they are related (consultant, other agreements, etc.). The article must be passed through an academic plagiarism detection program by the authors, and a plagiarism report must be submitted. The similarity rate should not exceed 20%. Depending on the similarity report result, the article may be sent to the handling editor for evaluation, returned to the author for correction, or rejected without being considered for evaluation (articles with a similarity rate exceeding 20%). The corresponding author is responsible for the final version of the article on behalf of all authors. The scientific, ethical, and legal responsibility of the articles lies with the author(s). (http://www.icmje.org/about-icmje/faqs/conflict-of-interest-disclosure-forms/). Authors are obligated to read the "Ethical Principles and Publication Policy" content.
