Journal Evaluation and Expectations from 2015

Dear Readers of JMIS,

It is the end of year 2014. This has been first year of Journal of Military and Information Science (JMIS). We tried JMIS to be indexed in different scientific indexes in order to reach wide numbers of researchers in the area of military science. JMIS has been selected for inclusion in the Worldcat (2014), Bielefeld Academic Search Engine (BASE, 2014), Directory of Research Journals

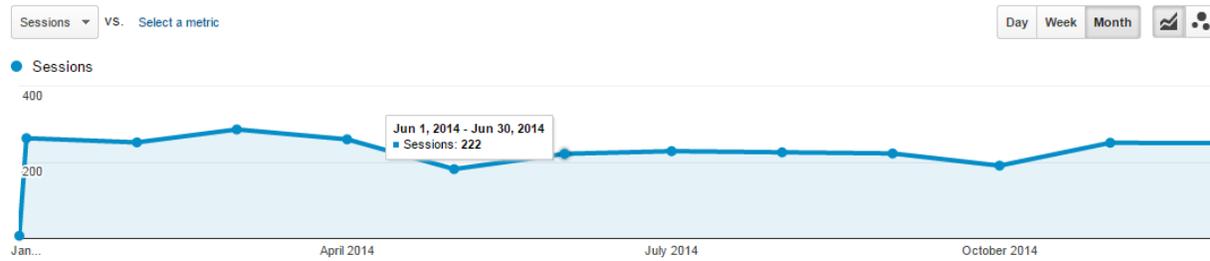


Fig.1.JMISCI sessions monthly (Google, 2014).

Indexing (DRJI, 2014), SJournals Index (2014), Open Academic Journal Index (OAJI,2014) databases. After inclusion in different databases, JMIS articles have been accessed several hundred times monthly (approximately between 200-400 accesses). This is a sign of growing interest as seen in Figure 1 (See Appendix for more information). Our vision is to be indexed in "Science Citation Index" in the future.

JMIS is an open access journal based on Open Journal System (OJS). It allows open access to the scientific content for all who register journal without demanding any cost. Our supporting lecturers decided to continue this policy for the next year. JMIS will also keep on free publication system for accepted articles. In addition, JMIS technical team added new tools for a friendly submission system.

Paper acceptance time for publication is a changeable factor due to evaluation process and the type of article. JMIS has the support of Turkish Journalpark and our intention is to pursue implementation of the digital object

identifier (DOI) system. Another issue is hardcopy publication. JMIS is an online journal and this situation will continue next year.

Supports from university and War College lecturers have continued during the year. This is a critical component of our success and ongoing existence in publication life. As JMIS editor, I would like to thank Col. Kadir Canpolat (Army War College), Prof.Dr.Cengiz Kahraman (ITU), Prof.Dr. Şeref Sağıroğlu (Gazi University), Prof.Dr. Orhan Torkul (Sakarya University), Dr. Özkan Bali (Military Academy) and all lecturers who have supported us during 2014. We see that there is growth in submissions, but our aim is

not to publish too many paper. Our editorial team want JMIS to be an outstanding journal in military science area. We expect the contribution of staff officers and people whose research interest are in military and engineering.
