Stratonikeian Incerta.^{} I.Stratonikeia 1504: a fragment of a letter to the Chrysaoreis**

ABSTRACT: An attempt is made here to reconstruct the text and to make sense of a tantalising small Hellenistic fragment from Stratonikeia in Karia (I. Stratonikeia 1504). It is argued that the fragment most probably belongs to a letter written by an agent of the Antigonid king Philip V to the league of the Chrysaoreis and that it was inscribed in the sanctuary of Chrysaorian Zeus.

KEYWORDS: Stratonikeia, Philip V, Chrysaoric league, Olympichos.

The following fragmentary inscription from Stratonikeia was published by M.Ç Şahin, first in *Epigraphica Anatolica* 41, 2008, 54–55, as no. 1 (with photograph) and subsequently in the third volume of his *In-schriften von Stratonikeia*, 2010, as no. 1504.¹ It is now in the site depot at Stratonikeia where I saw it in August 2014. The inscription was described by Şahin as follows: «Hellenistic fragment, found by the previous excavation team in 1984. Broken slab of marble whose upper and right sides are original, and there is a dowel hole at the upper face. In the museum depot at Stratonikeia. Available height 27 cm, width 22 cm, thickness 20.5 cm, height of letters 1.1–1.6 cm.» The block must have come «from a wall or structure» and Şahin thinks this may have been the temple of Chrysaorean Zeus. He dated the inscription, on letter forms, to c. 300–270 BC.



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Stratonikeia incerta, I.Stratonikeia 1504: Khrysaoreis Birliğine Yazılan Bir Mektubun Fragmanı

Öz: Makalede Karia kenti Stratonikeia'da ele geçen ve daha önce yayınlanmış resmi içerikli küçük bir metin fragmanı (I. Stratonikeia 1504) yeniden ele alınarak içeriğine anlam kazandırılmaya çalışılmıştır. Yapılan incelemede bu metnin büyük olasılıkla Antigonos Hanedanlığı kralı V. Philippos'un bir temsilcisi tarafından Khrysaoreis Birliği'ne yazılan bir mektuba ait olduğu ve söz konusu birlig'e ait Zeus Khrysaoreus tapınağında kaleme alındığı önerilmektedir.
