# Description of male of Chirotica orientalis Horstmann, 1983 (Hymenoptera, Ichneumonidae)

## Summary

The male of Chirotica orientalis Horstmann, 1983 is described for the first time on materials from Turkey.

#### Introduction

Western Palearctic species of genus *Chirotica* Foerster, 1869 was revised by Horstmann (1983). Sixteen species are known, most of them from Mediterranean area, but the male of only three species are known. After studying of materials, originated from Turkey, the male of *Chirotica orientalis* Horstmann was found and described as below.

Chirotica orientalis Horstmann, 1983: 20.

The species is described at two female specimens from South Turkey-Akbez and Gaziantep.

Male: Frons strongly striated transversely, dense and grob punctured lateraly. Antenna not so slender, third segment of flagellum 2,5 as long as wide. Tyloids linear, occupied all length of X-XII segments. Head and thorax covered with long white hairs.

Thorax exceptionally strongly rugulose punctured. Mesonotum dense and grob punctured in front half and strongly transversely striated in hind one. Pronotum, mesopleurum and metapleurum grob rugulose punctured.

First abdominal tergit except apical ridge, and second tergit in basal half coarse striated longitudinally. Third tergit fine striated in front third part, the next tergites brilliant, rare punctured. Abdomen compressed apicaly.

Legs slender, ratios among lenghts of hind tarsal segments  $52:22:15:9\cdot 13.$ 

Black; palpi and legs red, coxa and trochanters darkbrown, first tergit apicaly and all second tergit dark red, tegula yellow coloured.

Material examined: 3 d Diyarbakır, Turkey, 18.04.1985, from samples of Psychidae (Lepidoptera), leg. Ş. Karaat, one of them is deposited in the first author's, two of them are in the second author's collection.
