This time frame is acceptable considering the English editing and layout processes. However, we are continuing our search for new reviewers in an effort to reduce the review time. In addition, in order to achieve standardization in reviewing, we plan to organize a workshop for training reviewers on November 3, 2013, the last day of our National Congress. I kindly ask our reviewers to note the date. I would like to express that this workshop is open to everyone who would like to understand the stages of the reviewing process and receive training in scientific writing.
