- 20 **Camberwell Coal**  
Operations at a new open cut mine located in the Hunter Valley of New south Vales, Australia, producing coal for export to Japon.
- 27 **Coalbed Methane**  
The energy potential of methane contained in coal-bearing strata is enormous: reservoir engineering techniques can turn methane safety hazards to economic account.

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Power Resources inc. maintains an annual production of 1 Mlb  $U_3O_8$  from the Highland Project in Wyoming, one of the largest commercial in-situ groundwater leach uranium mines in the world.
- 65 **Raiseboring No. 4 Shaft at Kloof**  
The raiseboring of large diameter shafts has been accepted by most South African mining houses as a time-saving and cost effective method of shaft construction. Details are given of one shaft which proved to be an interesting challenge.
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Shaft drilling jumbos have come of age, reducing contract times and raising safety standards. Inco's McReedy East No. 1 ventilation shaft was the third in Canada to use this technique.
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
