We are proudly publishing the eighteenth (May 2021) issue of the Turkish History Education Journal (TUHED). In its 10th year, TUHED continues to publish without compromising its academic, international, peer-reviewed qualifications. TUHED is indexed in EBSCO's "Humanities Source Ultimate" and ULAKBİM's TR Index.

The editor of this issue is our editorial board member Prof. Dr. Selahattin Kaymakçı, from Kastamonu University. We thank him for his efforts and diligence.

As previously announced starting from the May 2021 issue our journal will apply a full-text English publication. This policy requires manuscripts in the Turkish language to also contain full-text English versions as well. Since the Dergipark system does not allow publishing in two languages we had to publish the Turkish and English versions of each article in a single pdf file. On the other hand, the peer-review process for manuscripts submitted in English was carried out in English and these articles were published in a single language form. A proofreading document was requested from the authors to ensure the clarity and comprehensibility of the English translations. We aim to have TUHED more recognized in the international academic community and have it indexed in Scopus, ESCI and ERIC, etc.

This issue of TUHED included 8 research & review articles and 2 translations. Studies in the field of educational history have made up the weight of the articles in this issue.

We would like to thank our referees and our supporting authors for contributing to the development of articles on a voluntary basis. Our journal will continue to be published in the fields of history education, historiography, and educational history.
