Authorship Criteria

Authorship is based on ICMJE criteria, requiring all authors to meet the following: (1) substantial contributions to the conception, design, data acquisition, analysis, or interpretation; (2) drafting or critically revising the manuscript for intellectual content; and (3) final approval of the version to be published. Contributions not meeting these criteria (e.g., funding acquisition, data collection, or general supervision) do not qualify for authorship but should be acknowledged with permission. Financial and material support must also be acknowledged. In multicenter trials, group authorship is permitted, with non-author contributors listed in the acknowledgments.

All opinions and statements in published articles reflect the authors' views, not those of the editors, editorial board, or publisher. The Journal of Baltalimani and its publisher assume no responsibility for claims in articles or advertisements.

Authors transfer copyright to the Journal of Baltalimani upon submission, per national and international regulations, by submitting a signed Copyright Transfer Form. Manuscripts without this form will not be considered. If rejected, copyright reverts to the authors. Accepted articles are published under the Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial (CC BY-NC 4.0) license, allowing non-commercial use with proper citation. Authors retain intellectual property rights, while commercial rights are transferred to the İstanbul Metin Sabancı Baltalimani Bone Diseases Training and Research Hospital. Authors are responsible for any legal or financial liabilities related to copyrighted materials (e.g., tables, figures).

Authors must complete the Authors' Contribution Form and the ICMJE Conflict of Interest Disclosure Form (available at <https://dergipark.org.tr/tr/pub/job>) at submission. Author names and affiliations will be published as listed on the Copyright Transfer Form, with no changes permitted post-submission.

Review Process

The Journal of Baltalimani employs a double-blind peer-review process to ensure originality, validity, and significance. Manuscripts are evaluated by external reviewers for content, methodology, and conclusions. A reviewer may be consulted if discrepancies arise. Reviewers remain anonymous, and the Editor-in-Chief makes the final decision on acceptance. Reviews are completed within one month, with reviewer comments shared with authors. Authors must address reviewer feedback point-by-point in revisions, specifying altered sections by page and paragraph numbers. Reviewers seeking assistance from colleagues must acknowledge their contributions and maintain manuscript confidentiality.
