

**Call for Papers for “Special Issue on Research Methods in Social Sciences”**



Celebrating 40. Years of its establishment, Anadolu University Graduate School of Social Sciences announces call for papers for “Special Issue on Research Methods in Social Sciences” which will be published in the Anadolu University Journal of Social Sciences in December 2022.

Articles for the special issue are expected to be sent through the DergiPark System in accordance with writing rules of the journal indicated as Author Guidelines in the DergiPark System. The information that the work has been sent for the “special issue” must be stated on the cover page. Publication of submitted articles is subject to evaluation of editorial board and peer-reviewed process of assigned referees.

### **Subjects of the Special Issue**

- Research Methods in Social Sciences (Either a broad discussion on research methods in social sciences or about a particular research method in social sciences can be discussed/investigated)
- Mixed Methods in Social Sciences (such as conventional research designs, unique designs, mixed research techniques)
- Quantitative research techniques in social sciences
- Qualitative research techniques in social sciences

- Systematic literature review in social sciences
- Employing machine learning, data mining, big data, deep learning techniques in social sciences
- Analyses of datasets in social sciences
- Publications derived from the graduate thesis in disciplines of social sciences
- Introduction and use of free of charge and open source software in quantitative and qualitative data analyses
- Adaptation and development of measurement scales in social sciences
- Research ethics in social sciences
